Joni Mitchell, a respected semiunderground folk talent from Canada roused a capacity audience last week at her "coming out" date at Carnegie Hall, N.Y. The performance reached its highpoint young Reprise Records artist in a top interpretation of "Get grossed \$10,800 at a \$5 top.
